
COVID-19 Handling: Whitmer v. Trump

Do you approve or disapprove of President Donald Trump's job performance?




Do you approve or disapprove of Governor Gretchen Whitmer's job performance?

Who do you think has done a better job handling the coronavirus: Donald Trump, or Gretchen Whitmer?







Voter Preferences in Presidential, Senate Races Leaning Dem



Worker Strikes and Paid Sick Leave: Voters' Views


COVID-19 has already impacted voters' views on several issues, making them less likely to support candidates who have opposed paid sick leave and increasing their support for striking workers.


Support the strike 56%




Does the coronavirus emergency make you less likely or more likely to vote for elected officials who have opposed paid sick leave, or does it not make a difference?


Less likely 47%




More likely 10%




There has been a proposal to end the school year now and allow all students who were on track to move ahead or graduate, to do so. Do you support or oppose this proposal?


Support 58%

Not sure 16%




Support 87%
