When it comes to the coronavirus pandemic, voters show a significant preference for Gov. Gretchen Whitmer's approach over the way President Trump has handled the crisis.






Do you approve or disapprove of Governor Gretchen Whitmer's job performance?

Who do you think has done a better job handing the coronavirus: Donald Trump, or Gretchen Whitmer?











### Voter Preferences in Presidential, Senate Races Leaning Dem


If the candidates for President this fall were Democrat Joe Biden and Republican Donald Trump, who would you vote for?



If the election for US Senate was held today, and the candidates were Democrat Gary Peters and Republican John James, who would you vote for?









# Worker Strikes and Paid Sick Leave: Voters' Views

COVID-19 has already impacted voters' views on several issues, making them less likely to support candidates who have opposed paid sick leave and increasing their support for striking workers.


