**Q1** Do you approve or disapprove of President Donald Trump’s job performance?

*Approve* ..... 44%  
*Disapprove*..... 52%  
*Not sure* ..... 4%

**Q2** Do you approve or disapprove of Governor Gretchen Whitmer’s job performance?

*Approve* ..... 53%  
*Disapprove*..... 40%  
*Not sure* ..... 7%

**Q3** If the election for President were held today, and the candidates were Democrat Joe Biden and Republican Donald Trump, who would you vote for?

*Joe Biden*..... 50%  
*Donald Trump* ..... 44%  
*Would vote 3rd party*..... 5%

**Q4** Have you seen any ads recently supporting President Donald Trump for re-election, or not?

**Q16** Some people say we should reinstate stay-at-home orders and other restrictions since the coronavirus outbreak in Michigan has recently gotten worse. Would you support or oppose re-imposing stay-at-home orders and other restrictions to help stop the spread of coronavirus?

**Q17** A group has announced plans to collect signatures for a citizen's initiative that would eliminate the Governor's emergency powers, such as those Governor Whitmer has used during the COVID-19 public health crisis. If enough signatures are collected, the Legislature can adopt the initiative and Whitmer cannot veto it. Do you support or oppose this initiative?

*Support* ..... 36%  
*Oppose* ..... 53%  
*Not sure* ..... 11%

**Q18** How would you describe the impact that the coronavirus pandemic has had on your household finances- a catastrophic effect, a major effect, a minor effect, or no effect at all?

*Catastrophic effect* ..... 8%

**Q19** As you may know, Michigan Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson recently mailed all registered Michigan voters absentee ballot request forms for the state's upcoming primary elections in August and for the general election in November. If the coronavirus pandemic is still a problem in November, which option for voting are you most likely to use in November: do you think you'll vote by mail using an absentee ballot, do you think you'll vote in person on Election Day, or do you think you will not vote?

*Think I'll vote by mail using an absentee ballot* ..... 56%  
*Think I'll vote in person on Election Day* ..... 40%  
*Think I won't vote* ..... 1%  
*Not sure* ..... 3%

**Q20** If Michigan is still seeing active cases of COVID-19 in August and November, how safe would you feel voting in-person: would you feel entirely safe, somewhat safe, or not safe at all?

*Entirely safe* ..... 32%  
*Somewhat safe* ..... 32%  
*Not safe at all* ..... 33%  
*Not sure* ..... 3%

**Q21** Regardless of how you plan to vote this November, how concerned are you that voting by mail using an absentee ballot could mean your vote is not counted because your ballot is lost in the mail or does not arrive in time: very concerned, somewhat concerned, or not concerned at all?

*Very concerned* ..... 39%  
*Somewhat concerned* ..... 21%  
*Not concerned at all* ..... 38%  
*Not sure* ..... 2%





**Q22** Regardless of how you plan to vote this November, how concerned are you that higher rates of voting by mail using an absentee ballot will lead to more voter fraud and impact the outcome of the election: very concerned, somewhat concerned, or not concerned at all?
