**Q1** Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove or strongly disapprove of President Joe Biden’s job performance?

Based on what you know, do you support or oppose Governor Whitmer's veto of the \$155 million to Grand Valley State University, or are you not sure?

**Q14** Betsy DeVos and Republican lawmakers have criticized Governor Whitmer’s decision to veto the proposal to give Grand Valley State University \$155 million for reading grants for students, but the Michigan Association of School Boards and the Michigan Association of Superintendents and Administrators encouraged the Governor to veto the proposal, saying the \$155 million would be better spent going directly to schools.
