
Vaccines and Vaccine Requirements Prove Popular

While the FDA's recent full authorization of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine appears to have done little to persuade Michigan's vaccine-hesitant minority to get vaccinated, the majority of Michigan is not only vaccinated but also supports vaccine requirements for individuals participating in indoor public activities.



Generally speaking, do you think the coronavirus vaccines are safe, or not?






Divisions on Michigan's Redistricting

Michiganders are split on their opinion of current districts and most are unsure the Commission will produce fair maps that accurately represent Michigan communities. Michigan's Independent Citizens Redistricting Commission is beginning the process of drawing new district maps.
