I have yet another case where body camera recordings have been "written over" by Detroit Police because 90 days had passed. The City prosecutor shifts blame as the defense didn't "request preservation" before the 90 days; yet, the Information was not signed by their office until after 90 days of the incident. Add to that, I did not get appointed for months thereafter. Somehow I am at fault for DPD's violation of state statute to preserve body camera evidence.

Anyway, I filed a motion. Tomorrow, I am arguing that Judge Sabree (36th DC) should (1) dismiss on due process grounds the OWI case because the defendant cannot present its best defense without the video or (2) order an evidentiary hearing where the officers, a detective, and former police chief James Craig, have to testify as to the policy of knowingly, willfully, and purposely, destroying body camera evidence after 90 days when it is clearly contrary to state statute MCL 780.316. I have specifically requested the former chief be ordered to testify to bring some real attention to this ongoing ridiculousness where Detroit destroys most all video evidence after 90 days. The super majority of cases have these recordings destroyed before ever getting to court. Even though there is a new chief, James Craig was chief at the time of the offense and I want to avoid having patrol officers testify to "just following policy" without anyone answering to why policy is enacted to order such destruction of evidence on a continuous basis.

From information that I have, the City's Law Department is a little rattled by this and fear an evidentiary hearing that may attract some attention from the media and otherwise sooner or later.

I have been waiting for the right audience (judge) to file this with and in my experience Judge Sabree is one of the fairest judge's on the 36th bench.

If you have any suggestions, please feel free to advise. And thank you to this forum as I used a lot of stuff from the various talented minds on here to draft the motion.
