- Q1** If a candidate for public office supported and praised former President Trump, would that make you more likely or less likely to vote for that candidate, or would it not make a difference?
- More likely*..... 25%
  - Less likely*..... 48%
  - Wouldn't make a difference*..... 26%
  - Not sure*..... 2%
- Q2** Do you think the 2020 Presidential election results were legitimate, or not?
- Results were legitimate*..... 58%
  - Results were not legitimate*..... 29%
  - Not sure*..... 13%
- Q3** Do you believe that former President Trump should be prosecuted for trying to overturn the 2020 election and his role in the January 6th attack on our Capitol, or not?
- Should be prosecuted*..... 52%
  - Should not be prosecuted*..... 42%
  - Not sure*..... 6%
- Q4** Recently, Michigan House Democrats introduced a resolution calling on the U.S. Department of Justice to investigate 11 Michigan House Republican lawmakers for seditious conspiracy for their actions attempting to overturn the 2020 election. Do you support or oppose the U.S. Department of Justice investigating the 11 Republican lawmakers?

**Q8** One year ago, Governor Whitmer announced a \$1.4 billion plan to expand affordable child care options using federal funds. One month ago, she signed eight bills into law to help existing child care centers stay open, new centers to open, and expanded eligibility for families who need financial assistance to afford child care. Do you support or oppose Governor Whitmer signing these child care bills into law?

*High school graduate or less* ..... 27%
